

Grade 4 Bike Education 2017



In 2017 the Grade 5 Bike Education Safety Program will run from **March 20-31 (Last 2 weeks of Term 1)**. We are also lucky to have Ride2School Program Co-Coordinator Jake Matthews conducting an induction session on Thursday March 16th for all Grade 4 students that will lead into our program.

Students will participate in 10 x 1 hour sessions that will include road safety, pedestrian safety & riding skills. Students will participate in sessions on school grounds. There will also be an opportunity for students to bring a Scooter (if they choose to) on 2 days of the program.

The program focuses on skills directly applicable to driving & pedestrian safety in the aim that students will be safer road users now & in the future. This is why it is imperative all students participate in the program, regardless of their bike riding skill level.

Students are required to provide their own bikes. **We ask that all students have a safe, working bike to use for the program.** This avoids large amounts of time repairing bikes for teachers & maximises the riding time during the program.

A detailed permission form will come home next week with further details.
