## 2021 Parent Payment Arrangements – Year 4

Dear Parent / Guardian / Carer,

Please find information included in this letter about the 2021 School Fee process. As I know you are all aware, we take great pride in the work we do with and for your children – and as such, really appreciate that our community makes paying their school fees a priority. This demonstrates that you value your child's education and the work we do to ensure we are offering quality learning programs. We appreciate that everyone's financial situations are different so have included support options below.

We think it's important that you know what your money is being used for – so this year we have provided an even more detailed breakdown of the fees we ask you to pay. We are a **non-profit organisation**. All money received or raised by the school is used to finance learning programs and to maintain and develop our school's buildings and grounds.

We make every effort to keep school fees to a minimum and affordable for all families, and greatly appreciate how our community makes paying school fees a priority. In 2020 over 90% of school fees were paid! This amazing payment rate meant we only had to redirect a small amount of other school funds to cover the cost of those that didn't make payment. This resulted in our planned budgets being able to be spent on purchasing new resources for classrooms, new equipment for our specialist programs and ongoing improvement to school facilities.

### Book Back and School Fee Process

2021 School Fees can be paid via either via Compass or by contacting the school office.  
Families that have credit will have this deducted from their school fees.

**Step 1** - Pay School Fees in full via Compass or by contacting the school office.

**Step 2** - If you made payment via Compass, the office will make contact to organise collection of the Book Pack or to have it sent home.

**Send the entire Book Pack to school with your child on the first day of school in 2021.**

Please do not name or label books.

### Financial Support for Families:

We understand that some families may experience financial difficulty and offer a range of support options, including:

- *Camps, Sports Education Fund (CSEF)*: If you hold a health care or pensioner benefit card, you may be eligible to apply for a payment from the Government to assist with the costs of camps and excursions.
- *Centrepay*: If you receive a payment from Centrelink you can choose to pay your school fees by having a regular amount paid to the school from your Centrelink payment.
